OUR HISTORY

SIU Professor R. Buckminster Fuller a.k.a. "father of the modern sustainability movement" began to plant the seeds of sustainability at SIU in 1957.

In 1999, SIU signed the Talloires Declaration, committing us to utilizing resources efficiently in order to reverse the trends of environmental degradation. (We were the first school in Illinois to sign!)

The Illinois Sustainable University Compact was signed by SIU in 2007, in which SIU pledged to achieve nine sustainability goals within the following year.

In 2007, Project Eco Dawgs was launched by students and staff to form a sustainability council and enact a Green Fee.

Our Sustainability Council consists of 3 students, 3 faculty, and 3 staff members.









THE GREEN FEE

Students changed the future of SIU in 2009 when they initiated a \$10 Green Fee.

It was approved by 73% of students who voted in a campus wide referendum.

On May 7, 2009 the SIU Board of Trustees unanimously passed the fee.


It provides a regular source of funding for on-campus sustainability projects.

Any current SIU student, faculty, or staff member is eligible to apply for a Green Fund project grant. Funding is awarded up to two times each semester.
