### Updates

#### #DawgGoneGreen

This football season, #DawgGoneGreen volunteers promoted recycling with SIU tailgaters. During evening games, the rate of recyclables diverted (from landfill) per attendee of the game raised 26% from our first home game. During afternoon games, the diversion rate per person improved 58%. Over 1.78 tons of recyclables were diverted overall! Many thanks to the volunteers, athletics, PSO staff, and patrons who contributed to the success of this program!



#### **Dawgs Nite Out**

During the November 13<sup>th</sup> Dawgs Nite Out, the Sustainability Office presented Zero Waste to students and staff. Zero Waste is a philosophy that encourages redesigning the waste stream so that the maximum number of products are reused instead of being sent to a landfill. At the event, we conducted a waste audit, which estimated that 86% of the current waste stream could be recycled or composted and doesn't have to be sent to the landfill! That's a lot of savings!
