Sustainability 101: The Fish Game



The Fish Game, from the Cloud Institute, is designed to start conversations on a variety of sustainability topics and to motivate people to take action. It is a simple 10-part game (played 10 rounds per game), which can be used to express concepts around sustainable resources.

Let's play the game!

Instructions:

For a round of game, you have 10 days to catch as many fish as you can from a lake. Remember that



- ~Harpoon fishing: take one fish.
- ~Long-line fishing: take two fish.
- ~Free-for-all long-line fishing: take three fish.

For each game, you can choose only one method for all rounds.

The lake only supports up to 20 fish at a time, and cannot exceed that. At the end of a round, the fish left will reproduce at 25%, meaning if you have for instance 7 fish left, you will have 7x25%=1.75 (round to 2), which is a total of 9.

Goal of the game: to have as many fish as possible after all 10 rounds are played.

Real-life connection:


Opportunities to:
